Questions to Ask About Driving Evaluation Programs

1. Elements of the evaluation

- a. Do you collect my driving history information?
- b. Do you collect my medical history?
- c. Is there a clinical testing component?
- d. What types of tests are involved?
- e. Is there a driving simulator or are the tests done on the road?
- f. Can an on-the-road test be done in my own car?

2. Who does the evaluation?

- a. How long have you been conducting evaluations?
- b. What are the credentials of the person conducting my evaluation?
- c. Approximately how many evaluations have you done?

3. How does the program work?

- a. How long does an evaluation take?
- b. Does the evaluation involve more than one visit?
- c. Can I or should I bring a family member with me?

4. Cost

- a. How much does it cost?
- b. Do you accept my insurance to cover any portion of the cost?

5. Results

- a. What does the report look like?
- b. Does the report include recommendations?
- c. Who gets a copy of the report from my evaluation?
- d. Do you send a copy to the MVA?
- e. Do you send a copy to my doctor?
